

**Minutes**

The meeting commenced at 2:00 pm at the Benton Clean Air Agency offices at 526 South Steptoe Street in Kennewick. Present at the meeting were:

Mr. Rodger indicated that the purpose of the meeting was to appoint a Large City Representative to the Benton Clean Air Agency Board. He stated that in the past a chair of the meeting was selected from those present.

Mayor Alvarez moved to approve the agenda; Mayor Taylor seconded, the agenda was unanimously approved.

Mayor Alvarez nominated Mayor McKay as Chair of the meeting, Mayor Pro Tem Brink seconded and the motion was approved with a 3 to 1 vote, with Mayor McKay as the dissenting vote.

Mayor McKay asked Mr. Rodger for expressions of interest for the position; he replied that one had been received from City of Kennewick to nominate Mayor McKay.

Mayor Pro Tem Brink nominated Mayor McKay to be the Large City Representative on the Benton Clean Air Agency board of directors, Mayor Alvarez seconded the motion.

Mayor McKay called for a vote that he be appointed as the Large Cities Representative on the Benton Clean Air Agency board for the four-year term ending on December 31, 2026. The motion was approved unanimously.

There being no further business, Mayor McKay adjourned the meeting at 2:04 pm.
